Friday, November 11, 2022

- The mission officially begins with a ruach-filled **Shabbat service** in Jerusalem with the **Chief Cantor of the IDF and the IDF Rabbinical** ensemble.

We'll travel from Begin's beginning as head of the Irgun, through his time as Prime Minister when he masterfully brokered the lasting peace treaty with Egypt.

- Spend the **evening with Lone Soldiers**, together with Nefesh B'Nefesh, a key partner organization for FIDF.

- **Meet with Sarit Gomez**, who lost her husband in the second Lebanon War while she was six months pregnant with their first child, and Michal Keidar who lost her husband Lt. Col Dolev Keidar, who was killed in Gaza during Operation Protective Edge.
